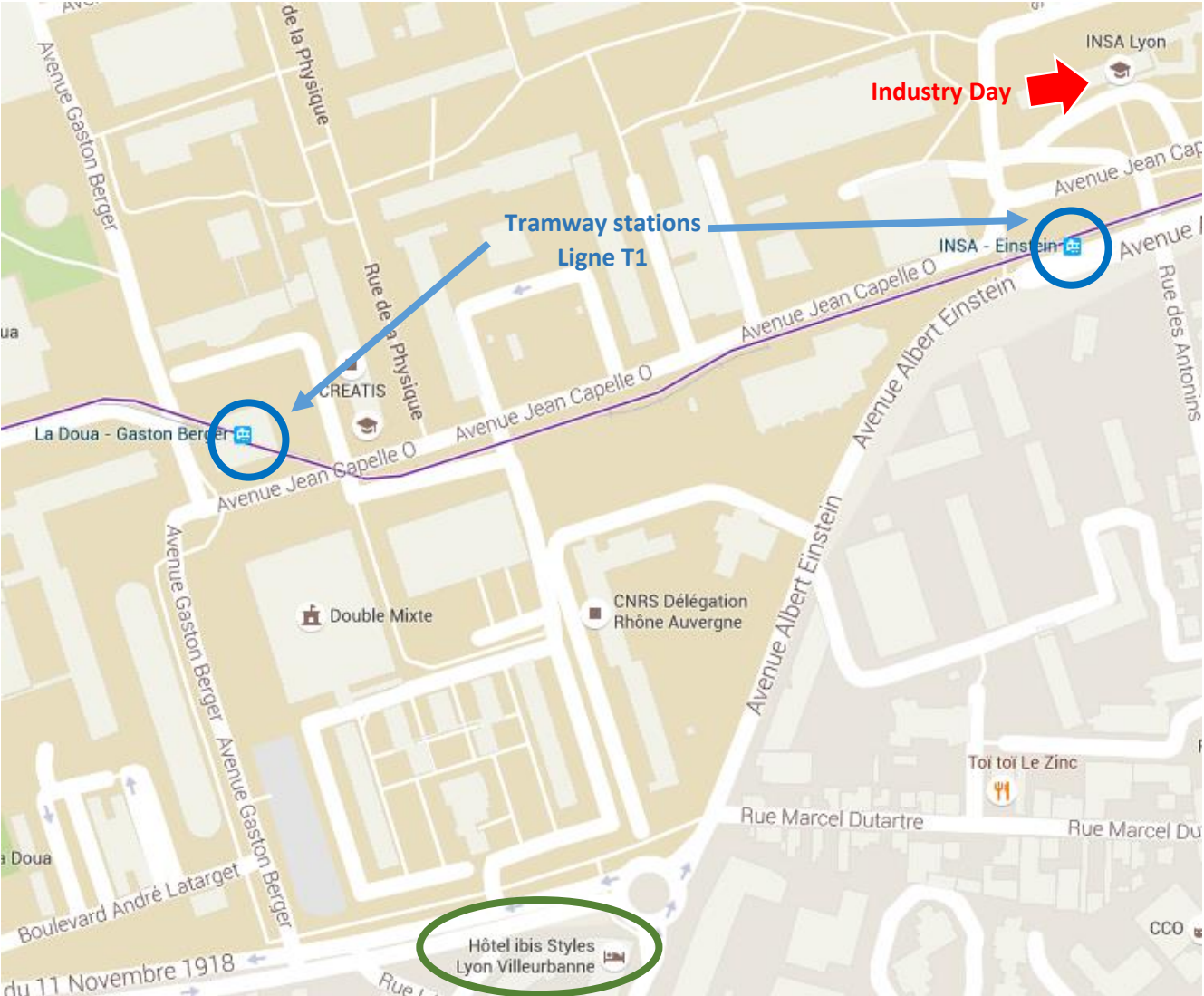

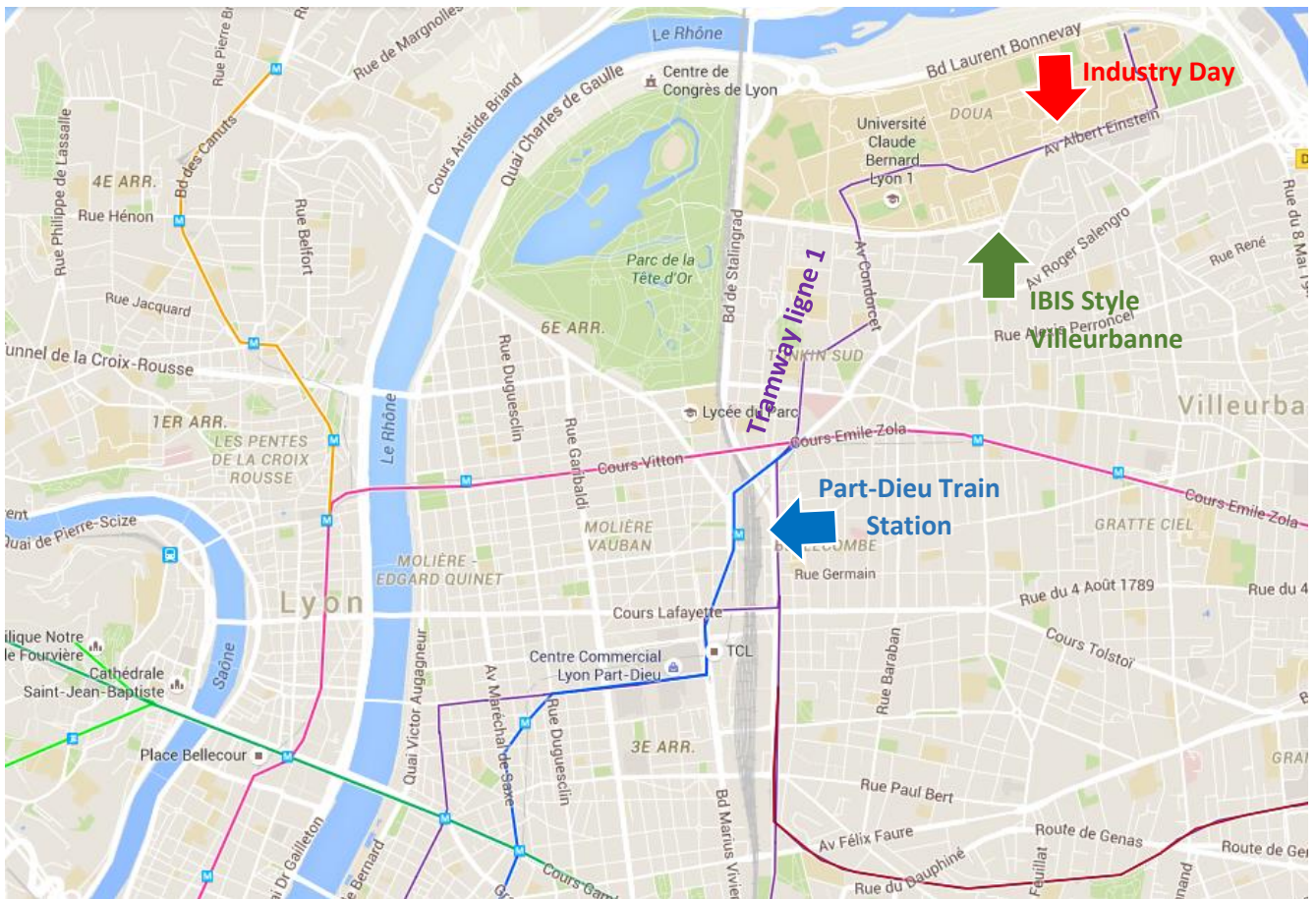

## From Gare Part Dieu to the INSA Lyon



### HOW TO COME:

- 1- by plane to LYS airport (Lyon Saint Exupéry Airport).
- 2- From the airport to the Part Dieu train station: there is a shuttle (Rhonexpress) that links the airport to the Part Dieu train station. It takes about 30 min, shuttle every 15 min, tickets can be purchased [online](#) or directly on the train.
- 3- From the Part Dieu train station to the campus or the IBIS hotel: there is a public tramway "T1 Direction IUT Feysine". It takes about 40 min. Tickets can be purchased on the tramway platform.
- 4- From INSA to the Part Dieu train station : tramway "Ligne T1 Direction Debourg"
